*Rising Water Worcester*

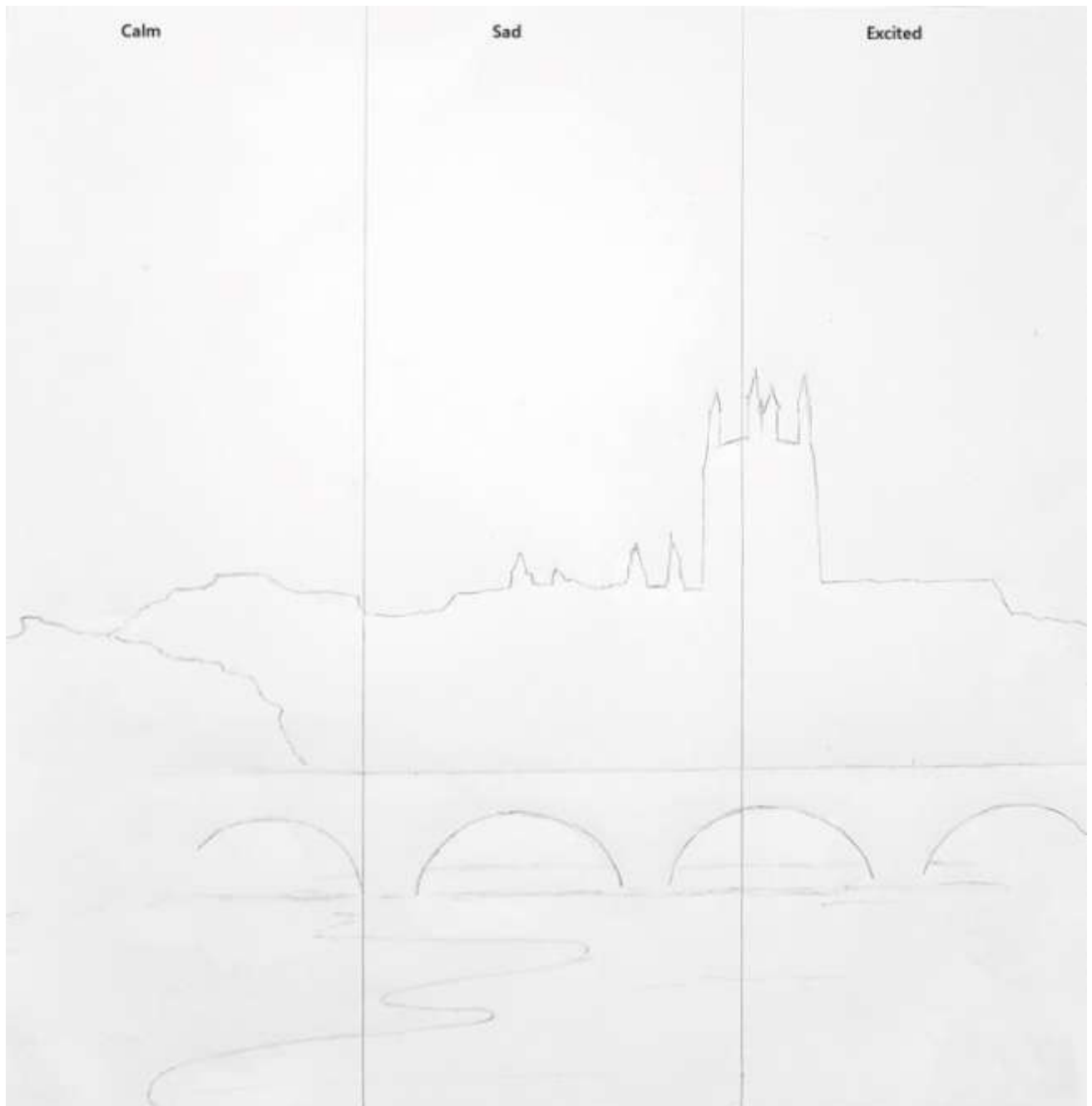
### Use a simple outline sketch to express your creativity through colour...

The outline sketch below shows the basic shapes in my painting 'Rising Water Worcester'. You'll see it's divided into 3 columns. Print out the outline sketch, grab some coloured pencils, crayons or paints and choose either option (a) or (b). Use colours to create a feeling of calm in column 1, sadness in column 2 ... and so on. Each column should end up looking quite different from the others.

- a) **Feelings** – Column 1: CALM \* Column 2: SAD \* Column 3: EXCITED
- b) **Seasons** - Column 1: SPRING \* Column 2: AUTUMN \* Column 3: WINTER

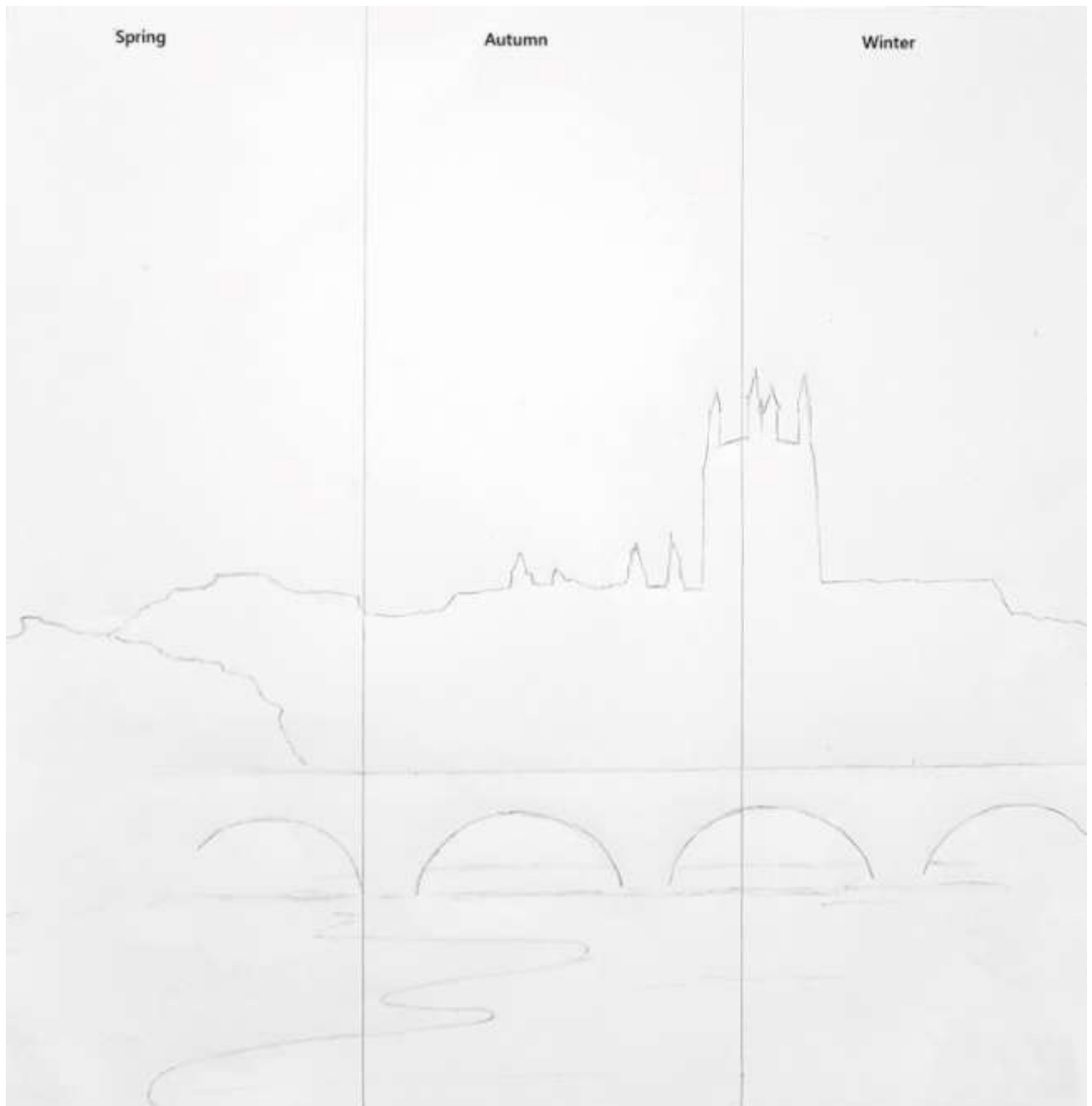
